During the month of August 2025, the school held a "Meet and Greet" with families and provided school supplies to families that requested school supplies. In addition, the school provided uniforms to two students whose parents informed us of a need of assistance.
	The school provides childcare during parent meetings and workshops. School staff reads stories and plan arts and craft activities so parents can attend informational meetings. Our school also offers a principal operated after school care program.
